LAKE PLACID, 13th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1980

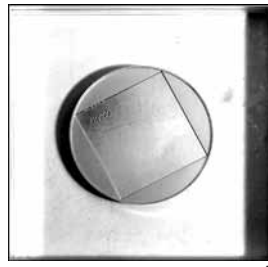

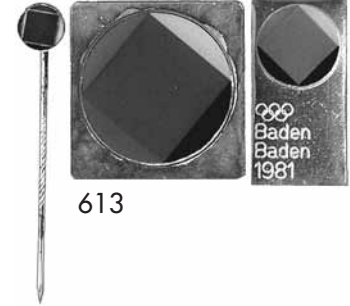
