#### ATHENS, 1st OLYMPIC GAMES, 1896

152. (Book) **Greece During the 1896 Olympic Games. Panhellenic Illustrated Album.** Athens, 1896. Published by Newspaper Acropolis, printed by Newspaper Hestia. 358pp. illustrated, many plates, 29x43.5cm (11.4"x17.1"), in Greek. Pages 92 to 134 are dedicated to the 1896 Olympic Games with many photographic illustrations: American team, the diploma, the stadium, etc. Page 133/134 is photocopied. Half red leather and black gold stamped leatherette, scuffed, gold lettering on spine, marbled end papers, pages gold on end, contents VF-EF. Scarce and informative report. (**\$2,000**)

#### PARIS, 2nd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1900

*The 1900 Paris Olympic Games were held in conjunction with the World's Exposition. They played only a minor role. There were athletes who didn't know that the events they participated in were Olympic Games events. Few items relate directly to the Games. For this reason we are also offering items commemorating the World's Exposition.*

153. **Large Silver Jury Plaque.** 8.2x13.8cm (3.2"x5.4") uniface, by L. Bottée, (made by Christofle). Fame seated, holding palm branch and trumpet, radiant and winged torch over "1900" above, "JURY" on panel below. *The Jury badges for Paris 1900 were modeled after this design.* EF. Very rare. (**\$3,500**)
154. **Silver Winner's Plaque of the XXVth Federal Gymnastics Festival.** Silvered bronze, 41x59mm, by F. Vernon. Winged goddess scattering laurel branches over Paris exposition grounds. Rev. Victorious athlete standing on podium inscribed "XXVIme Fête Fédérale De Gymnastique" in 3 lines. EF. (**\$1,250**)
- 154a. **Bronze Award Plaque by the Minister of Sports.** Bronze, 41x59mm, by F. Vernon. Victorious athlete standing on podium. Rev. 4-line French award legend over laurel branch. Toned EF. (**\$900**)

155. **French Republic Silver Award Medal for Exposition Workers.** Silver, hallmarked, 30mm, by Chaplain. Winged female carrying torchbearer over Paris, city shield below. Rev. 6-line French legend, name on panel. Looped, with ribbon in tricolor French colors. EF. Rare. (\$475)

156. **Judge's Plaque.** Silvered bronze, 36x50mm, by Roty. Rose and laurel branches over Paris exposition grounds. Rev. Young winged boy (New Century) taking torch from sleeping woman (19th Century). Toned EF. (\$275)

157. **The History Medal of the Paris Mint, 1900.** Bronze, 50mm, by D. Dupuis. Winged young nude cherub with torch leaning on coining press. Rev. History seated in clouds writing "1900" in book. EF. (\$150)

158. **Baron Pierre de Coubertin Carte de Visite, 20 Rue Oudinot (Around 1900).** 10.6x6.7cm (4.2"x2.6"). ### ST. LOUIS, 3rd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1904

The 1904 Olympic Games in St. Louis were also held in conjunction with a World's Fair. This, again, detracted a lot from the importance of the Games. Few items are available that relate directly to the Olympiad, and they usually command very high prices. For this reason we are also offering some memorabilia from the World's Fair which celebrated the Centennial of the Louisiana Purchase from Napoleon in 1803.

c160. **International Committee (IOC) Badge.** Bronze, 40x40mm octagonal, made by Dieges & Clust, New York. Nude athlete striding r., laurel branch in hand. Rev. Legend in eleven lines, shields of St. Louis, France and U.S.A. between ivy leaves. Loop and ring at top. Suspended from goldplated bar inscribed "International Committee" and multicolor striped ribbon, inscribed in gold "ST. LOUIS/SEPT./1904". Elbel no photo, unnumbered. EF. Extremely rare. (\$25,000)

c161. **Colorful Enameled St. Louis 1904 Pin.** Goldplated, multicolor enamel, 54x50mm. St. Louis Exposition 1904 shield surrounded by 5 stylized flowers. Beautiful pin. EF. (\$325)

162. **St. Louis 1904 Flag Pin.** Gilt aluminum, 18x16mm. EF. (\$110)

163. **Official Bronze Souvenir Medal of the St. Louis World's Fair.** Bronze, 34mm. Conjoined busts l. of Napoleon and Jefferson. Rev. Map of U.S. with Louisiana Territory purchased in 1803. EF, a few spots. (\$135)

164. **Commemorative Medal of the St. Louis World's Fair, 1904.** Silvered, 36mm. Color enameled logo of the Fair, affixed. Rev. View of Cascade Gardens. Riffled edge. EF. (\$125)

c165. **Official Monogram St. Louis 1904 Cup.** Goldplated brass on wooden base, 10cm (3.9") tall. Cup with affixed color enameled monogram of the Fair and gilt panel with legend. EF. (\$150)

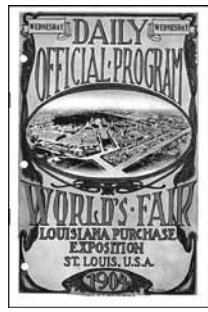

167. **Commemorative Gold and Black Porcelain Bowl.** 16cm (6.3"), made by Victoria, Carlsbad. View of Palace of Varied Industries, St. Louis Exposition 1904 legend below in gold flower border. Scalloped gilt edge, lt. wear on black legend, o.w. EF. (\$125)
168. **Commemorative White Opalene Cup.** 12.5cm (4.9") high. Views of Cascade Gardens, Palace of Machinery, Louisiana Purchase Monument and St. Louis Union Station between ornate scroll work. Flower design on bottom. EF. (\$100)

174. **Victory and Panathenian Olympic Stadium Medal.** Bronze, 23mm. Winged victory with laurel branch. Rev. Aerial view of the stadium. Looped, toned VF. (\$125)
175. **(Brochure) Program of all Events, and the Festivities.** 23pp., 15.3x23cm (6"x9.1"), in Greek and French languages. Complete program of all events by day and hour, plus program of reception for all participants, theater programs, concerts and archeological visits, etc. Browning, cover torn, taped, crease, VF. - c179. **First Place 200 Metres Team Swimming Winner's Medal Presentation Case.** Dark red leather with gold legend, 74x74mm. Lined in red velvet and cream silk. EF. (\$550)
180. **Second Place 7 Metre Yacht Race Winner's Medal Presentation Case.** Leather with gold legend, 68x68mm. Lined in purple velvet and cream silk. EF. (\$450)
- c181. **British Olympic Track & Field Athlete's Patch for the London 1908 Games.** Linen embroidered in 6 different colors, 11.8x13.2cm (4.6"x5.2"). 186. **Pair of British A.A.A. Olympic Games Trials Races Winner's Medals, 1912.** Silver, 37mm and 30mm, by Vaughton. British shield. Rev. "A.A.A. 1912 Putting the Weight 1st (Place)" in open laurel wreath. And Spoked wheel. Rev. "A.A.A. 1912 Throwing the Discus 2nd" in open laurel wreath. Both EF. (2 pcs.) (\$300)
187. **Large Stockholm Olympic Stadium Plaque.** Cast bronze, 24.5x16.5cm (9.7"x6.5"), by H. Tengborn. Participant's badge and flags above Stockholm. Olympic stadium, wisteria flowers on either side, Olympic legend below. *Very attractive Art Nouveau plaque.* EF. (\$650)
