

NAGANO, 18th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1998

- 784. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Nagano logo over legend. Rev. Wooded mountainside. EF, in box with gilt logo. (\$375)
- c785. **Swiss Olympic Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enameled in color, 56x56mm. Logo between Japanese and Swiss shield. Rev. Japanese and English legend. Unc., in presentation case. (\$300)
- c786. **Swiss Team Pin Set.** 12 color enameled pins, 33x26mm each, showing different sports. Unc., cased. (12 pins) (\$175)
- 787. Nagano 1998 Winter. Official Guide Book. First printing, June 1997, published by the Organising Committee. 192pp. illus. in color, 10x21cm (3.9"x8.3"), in English. Program, venues, Olympic Winter Games since 1924, Nagano and surroundings, travel, accommodation, etc. With separate guide map. Yellow-brown covers. EF. (\$100)
- 788. **The Official Olympic Program.** 175pp. illus. in color, 21x29.6cm (8.3"x11.7"), in English. Contains all the important information for the Nagano 1988 Winter Games. EF. (\$125)

SYDNEY, 27th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2000

- c789. Silver Second Place Winner's Medal Awarded for Baseball. Silver, 68mm, by Wojciech Pietranik. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Olympic rings over Sydney opera house and Sydney torch. Last time the obverse design since 1928 Amsterdam was on a winner medal. New design since Athens 2004. With blue ribbon embroidered in silver "SYDNEY 2000". EF. (\$9,500)
- c790. **Team Dressage Seventh Place Badge with Ribbons for the Winning Horse.** Silvered center with logo surrounded by 3 different circular cockades in different blue shades, 17.9cm (7.1"). With 5 long ribbons with silver legend. Very decorative and rare. Lt. wear in center o.w. EF. (\$2,250)
- 791. **Participant's Pin Presented by the IOC.** Goldplated, 13x20mm. Numbered, in white plastic wallet. EF. (\$100)
- c792. **Swiss Olympic Team Medal.** Silvered, multicolor enamel, 56x56mm. Sydney logo between Australian and Swiss flags. Rev. 3-line English legend. Unc., in presentation case. (\$275)


- 793. **Swiss Team Pin Set.** 16 multicolor enameled pins with affixed athletes for different events, 29x25mm. Unc., cased. (16 pins) (\$200)
- 794. **Sydney 2000. Set of 23 Ukrainean Team Pins.** Goldplated, color enameled, 11x29mm. EF, in original case. (**\$100**)

SALT LAKE CITY, 19th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2002

- 795. **Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and glass, 83.8cm (33") long. Shaped like a fiery icicle in motion, the polished silver colored bottom bears the motto "Light the fire within"; center metal and glass top section in "frozen flame" texture with logo on metal part. EF. (\$2,500)
- 796. **Soviet Paralympic Team Medal.** Goldplated, 39mm. Paralympic logo. Rev. Russian double-headed eagle. Unc., in red presentation case. (\$100)
- 797. Complete Set of 16 Daily Programs, Day 1 and 2, Feb. 9 and 10, 2002 to Day 17 February 24, 2002. Illustrated in color throughout. EF. (16 issues.) (\$175)
- 798. **Official Program.** 148pp. illus. in color, 22.3x26.6cm (9"x10.5"). Violet and silver covers. EF. (\$100)

ATHENS, 28th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2004

- 799. **Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and olive wood, 68cm (26.8") long. The torch resembles an olive leaf, and the design wants to express "Pan Metron Ariston" (All things in moderation, translated from Greek). A simple and beautiful design. EF. (\$2,350)
- 800. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 50mm. Athens 2004 logo. Rev. Games legend. Greek text and wavy decoration on both sides. Mounted inside cardboard, between color covers. Space for participation diploma inside back cover. EF. (\$275)
- 801. **Paralympic Participation Medal.** Bronze, 50mm. Athens 2004 Paralympic logo. Rev. Legend. Greek text and wavy decoration on both sides. Mounted inside cardboard, between color covers. Space for participation diploma inside back cover. EF. (\$225)



- 802. **Swiss Team Pin Set.** 20 multicolor, domed pins for different events, 18x34mm. Unc., cased. (20 pins). (\$200)
- c803. **Pair of Commemorative Porcelain Plates.** Both 21cm (8.3"), by Efsimon. "Olympia 2004" around logo, lt. and dark blue. And "Athens 2004 Olympic Games" within legend, blue and grey. EF. (2 pcs.) (\$125)
- 804. **Kazakhstan Team Shirt.** White with blue design, Athens 2004 logo on r. arm. Large size. EF. *No photo*. EF. (\$125)
- 805. **Fifth Place Winner's Diploma Awarded in Boxing Welter Weight.** Multicolor, 20.9x29.8cm (8.2"x11.7"). Facsimile signatures of IOC and Athens 2004 Organizing Committee Presidents. In slipcover. EF. (\$275)
- 806. **Complete Set of 35 Olympic Sports Leaflets.** Multicolor, 6pp. foldout, 9.9x20.9cm (3.9"x8.2") each section, in Greek. Mascots illustrate different sports on cover. EF (\$100)
- c807. **Athens 2004. Named Participation Diploma.** Multicolor, 21x29.6cm (8.3"x11.7"). EF. (\$175)

TORINO, 20th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2006

- c809. Cased Silver Winner's Medal for Figure Skating Mixed Ice Dancing. Silver, 10.7cm (4.2"), designed by Dario Quatrini. Torino logo. Rev. Figure skater and inscription "Figure Skating / Men's Single". Edge inscribed "XX Olympic Winter Games" in Italian, French and English. The empty space in the center represents the Italian piazza. With multicolor silk ribbon. In presentation case, EF. (\$14,500)
- 810. **Official Torch.** Blue techno-polymer-coated aluminum, 77cm (30.3") long, made by Pininfarina. The fire was lit in Olympia on November 27, 2005, and arrived in Rome on December 8. Until February 10 the torch traveled over 11,300 km across Italy, also France, Switzerland and Slovenia. EF. (\$2,250)
- 811. (Graphic Manual) Torino 2006. Look of the Games Made Simple. Draft 2 15/9/05. 29 pages illustrated in color, 42.5x29.8cm (16.7"x11.7"). Color palette, application examples, look of all venues, the Olympic Village etc. Spiral bound. EF. Scarce. (\$200)

- c812. Silver Second Place Winner's Medal Awarded for Baseball. Silver, 70mm, with inlaid light green jade. Winged goddess of Victory above Panathenian Stadium in Athens. Rev. Logo in center surrounded by jade, event engraved at top. Ornate loop, with red and orange ribbon with "Beijing 2008" and Olympic rings. Baseball was an Olympic event only from 1992 to 2008. EF. (\$9,750)
- c813. **Official Torch.** Red and anodized aluminum, 72cm (18.4") long. Curved form in the shape of a paper scroll, with lucky clouds graphic expressing harmony. The torch relay started in Olympia, Greece, on March 24, traveled to over 100 cities on five continents and all of China, a distance of 137,000km. Although a large number of torches were made they remain extremely hard to find. EF. (\$5,500)
- 814. Commemorative Bird's Nest Olympic Stadium and Mascots Medal. Copper, 80mm (3.1"), by China Printing and Minting Corporation. 3-dimensional view of the stadium with doves at opening ceremony. Rev. Five Fuwa mascots. EF. In wooden box and case. (\$150)
- c815. Red Torchbearer T-Shirt and Shorts Set. Medium size. White, torch relay logo with red and gray design, large Beijing 2008 over color rings on back. Shorts with torch relay logo and rings. EF. (2 pcs.) (\$125)

VANCOUVER, 21st OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2010

- 816. **Official Torch.** Stainless steel, aluminum and white sheet molding compound, 94.5cm (37.1"), made by Bombardier. The lines of the torch reflect the lines made by snow and ice winter sports. It shows the engraved motto "With Glowing Hearts / Des plus brilliants exploits" and the logo. The torch relay ended after its 45000 km journey through Canada with the lighting of the Olympic flame cauldron at the opening ceremony on February 12, 2010. EF, with original protective sleeve and mailing box. (\$2,250)
- c817. Silver Medal Winner's Diploma Awarded for Speedskating Men's 1000M. Green and blue stiff paper, 30.5x23cm (12"x9.1"), rings and logo in silver. In presentation envelope. Plus Closing Ceremony Korean Flagbearer's Accreditation. Pink, laminated, 9x14cm (3.5"x5.5"). The speedskater was chosen to lead the Korean team in the Closing Ceremony due to his unexpected gold and silver medal victory. Both EF (2 pcs.) (\$2,000)

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
