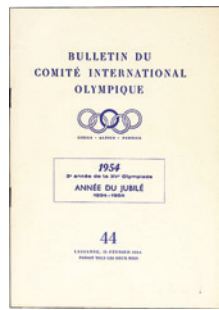

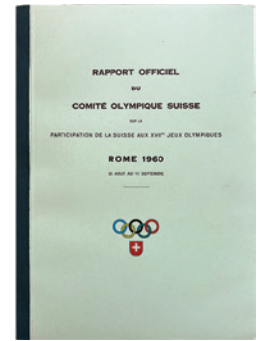

225. **Cortina 1956 Winter. Trio of Gold, Silver and Bronze Small Size Participation Medals.** All 40mm, by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower right. Rev. Snowflake superimposed on Mount Pomagagnon. All EF. (3 pcs.) (\$1,200)

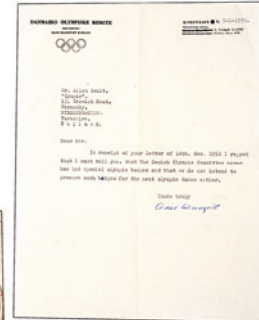

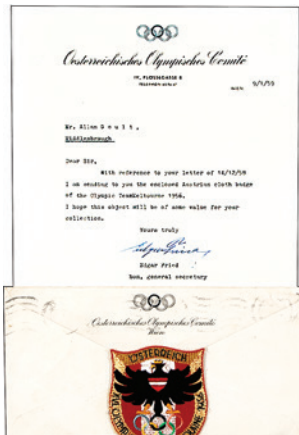

228. **STOCKHOLM, 16th OLYMPIC EQUESTRIAN GAMES, 1956 Participation Medal of the Stockholm 1956 Equestrian Olympic Games.** Bronze, uniface, 42x50mm, by J. Sjösvärd. Ancient Greek horseman l. over Olympic rings, the official emblem of the Equestrian Olympic Games. *Since the horses could not be brought to Australia due to a 6-month quarantine requirement, the Games were awarded to Stockholm.* Toned EF. **(\$3,500)**
229. **MELBOURNE, 16th OLYMPIC GAMES, 1956 Melbourne 1956. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 63mm, by A. Meszaros. Olympic rings over Melbourne coat of arms within legend. Rev. Olympic motto within circle of athletes marching in pairs. EF. **(\$300)**
230. **Melbourne 1956. Modern Pentathlon Mexican Participant's Badge.** Silver, attached logo in color, 38mm. Toned EF. **(\$240)**
231. **Earliest Vietnam NOC Pin.** 15x20mm. Yellow with 3 red stripes in center, "VIETNAM" on green above. Very rare. EF. **(\$150)**
232. **50th Anniversary Medal of the Czech National Olympic Committee, 1956.** Silvered bronze, 81mm, by S. Nejd. Czech lion over rings between "1896-1956". Rev. Torchbearer running left. EF. **(\$120)**

233. **Melbourne 1956 Patch and Letter with Envelope from the Canadian Olympic Association, also a 1956 Patch and Letter with Envelope from the Bulgarian Olympic Committee,** Sent to a British Collector in 1959. Patches are 9 cm and 9x9.5 cm, both EF. Letters and envelopes VF. **(\$100)**
234. **Austrian Team Patch for Melbourne 1956 together with a Letter and Envelope from the Austrian Olympic Committee.** Patch is 7x8.5 cm.
